Students may choose any of UTA's on-campus housing options, though all accommodations are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

EARLY APPLICATION

It is very important that students apply for housing as soon as they receive their UTA ID number and login credentials. Housing on and near campus fills up very quickly.

MOVE-IN DATE

Students cannot move in to UTA housing until a few days before classes begin. Students should plan accordingly and be prepared to stay in a hotel if they arrive in Arlington before they are able to move in to their UTA housing.

MEAL PLANS

Students living in most UTA residence halls are required to purchase a meal plan. Students in other UTA housing may also wish to purchase a meal plan.

Student will be issued a Mav Express Card. This card serves as a student ID, a library card and allows access to services such as dining, photocopying, health services, bookstore, etc.

RESIDENCE HALL WINTER HOLIDAY CLOSINGS

Most UTA Residence Halls close for winter break (mid-December to mid-January). Academic Year students who wish to live on-campus for winter break should apply for winter session housing. UTA Apartments stay open year-round.

OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING INFO

Students may also live off-campus if they choose, but there are some important things to consider:

- There is no public transportation in Arlington, so it is essential that students live within walking distance of UTA.
- Many off-campus apartments may require a one-year lease and many will not come furnished.

ACADEMIC INFORMATION & NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

UTA has 9 different colleges and over 50 subject areas available for study. Common subjects exchange students take include:

- **Architecture, Planning & Public Affairs**

COURSES

Courses available during the fall semester (August-December) will be posted in mid March.

Courses available during the spring semester (January-May) will be posted in mid-November.

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

Course availability changes from semester to semester.

UTA Study Abroad Staff will assist students with academic advising and enrollment.

ENROLLMENT

Students may enroll in any course for which they meet the prerequisites. Courses are offered on a per semester basis only. Enrollment in any specific course cannot be guaranteed.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATIONS

Students are required to complete orientation modules in Canvas and will not be cleared to enroll in courses until they have completed these modules.

Students must also participate in an in-person orientation upon arrival to Arlington.

Students cannot enroll in courses until they have completed International Student Orientation and submitted proof of vaccination against bacterial meningitis.

HEALTH-RELATED REQUIREMENTS

All international students (including exchange students) are required to purchase the UT System International Student Insurance. Students may submit a waiver request, but very few students will qualify for an insurance waiver. Students should plan to purchase the UT System insurance. They can pay the cost of the insurance in installments after they arrive in Arlington and have registered for classes. Our office will provide the cost for this insurance in student acceptance packets.

REQUIRED HEALTH INSURANCE

In fall 2014, all University of Texas System schools adopted new insurance regulations.

TUBERCULOSIS TESTING

All international students are required to have a TB screening.

MENINGITIS VACCINATION

All new students under the age of 22 are required to have a meningitis vaccination. The vaccination must be done at least 10 days before the start of the semester.

Students are responsible for the costs of the TB screening and meningitis vaccination.
